* Bonus: Spectacular lower Mississippian and Upper Ordovician Stratigraphy)

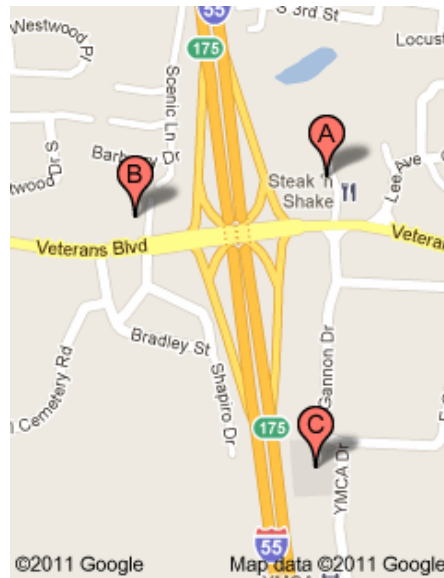
6. Mastodon State Park and museum (if time permits).
